**JUDGE - Jeri Greenberg [www.jerigreenbergart.com](http://www.jerigreenbergart.com)**

Our honored judge this year is Jeri Greenberg, a Signature Member in the Pastel Society of America and a Master Circle Pastelist in the International Association of Pastel Societies (IAPS). She started her career as a fashion illustrator, went into advertising and printing and then back to her first love - pastel painting. To Jeri, pastels represent pure color and pure joy. She currently teaches and conducts workshops throughout the country. Jeri has won numerous pastel awards.

**ELIGIBILITY**

Any member of the Piedmont Pastel Society, Charlotte NC who has paid their 2019 dues may enter up to three paintings. We encourage artists at all skill levels to enter. Bring your art and your passion to this year's show! In keeping with our Mission Statement, the show is about promoting opportunities for all of our members, regardless of skill level. Our judge will select a "*Best in Show*" winner via an on-line process; therefore, images must be received no later than 10/20/19. During the opening reception, she will explain her criteria for selecting the painting. Her insight will increase our understanding of what comprises an outstanding piece of art.

**ENTRIES**

All entries must be submitted by the artist and be an original pastel work containing at least 80% hard/soft pastels and painted in the last two years. Paintings that won an award in a previous PPS Member Show or the NC Statewide Exhibition are not eligible. Oil pastels are not accepted. Works completed under the supervision of a teacher, workshop or copied from published photographs are not eligible. Nude paintings are not accepted as we must adhere to The Cornwell Center's guidelines. Artwork must be securely framed and ready to be hung. For safety reasons, saw tooth hangers cannot be accepted. Your entry should contain your name, address, phone number, email, image title, size and price. Artwork labels can be printed from the PPS Website.

## AWARDS

All participants are eligible for two awards. The “*Best in Show*” winning artist will receive a \$250 cash award. In addition, all PPS members will have the opportunity to select the “*People’s Choice*” award, the winner of which will receive a cash award of \$50. Because awards will be selected digitally, only images emailed to Darlene will be eligible.

During the reception, Jeri will announce the winners and provide feedback on the “*Best in Show*” winner’s painting. She will also “walk the show” offering feedback to artists present at the Opening Reception, as time permits.

## SALES

Paintings may be sold according to arrangements between the artist and buyer. Artwork must remain on exhibit through December 6. Paintings are not required to be for sale. The Cornwell Center charges a 30% commission fee.

## PROCEDURES TO ENTER

The show will kick-off in November. Go to the Piedmont Pastel Society website to sign-up and pay the entry fee of \$35. [www.piedmontpastelsociety.org](http://www.piedmontpastelsociety.org)

The title of your painting and the sale price (if for sale) is required for all entries. If your painting is not for sale, write “NFS” in the show’s entry form on the PPS website.

## PHOTOGRAPH YOUR ART

Before your art is framed, create a digital file which will be used for the online judging process. - File Format: JPEG
- Title: Name of the painting. Example: “The Young Dancers”.
- Resolution: Use the highest camera setting
- File Size: 3MB maximum
