It was a fabulous experience, and I created a painting from Albert's reference photo that he generously allowed us to use. My painting from the workshop is called Journey Through Rocks.


I create landscape and botanically inspired soft pastel, impressionistic paintings. There is inspiration everywhere. Living in the rolling hills of Caledon, Ontario surrounded by trees, ponds, rivers and flowers, I'm inspired by the ever-changing light and color that nature provides.

Since early childhood I have always expressed myself with artistic endeavors. I went on to study drawing and painting in all different styles and mediums from pen and ink, charcoal, acrylic, oil, watercolor and soft pastels. In my late teens, I was creating large, abstract, 3-dimensional, papier mache, acrylic paintings rented to corporations through Arts Etobicoke (Ontario). At the end of high school, I received an Award of Excellence in Art Scholarship. 


### **Member News**


